

**Ozaukee Art Center
Wine & Harvest Festival, September 19-20, 2009**

- TIME:** Saturday, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Registration from 7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Saturday
- LOCATION:** Downtown Cedarburg
- MEDIA:** Painting, sculpture, graphics, photography, fiber, metal, glass, clay, wood.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any U.S. artist 18 years or older. Work selected by jury from slides or good photos. All work must be handmade originals, no work made from commercial kits or molds. Festival sponsors reserve the right to refuse to display work inconsistent with slides submitted or by artist not conforming to rules enclosed herewith and regulation. No class work accepted.
- ENTRY:** Fill out and sign entry card, return card with five 35mm slides or photos, a short resume, and fees. Include self-addressed stamped envelope if you want slides returned. Please write your medium on front of your application package so entries can be processed efficiently.
- FEES:** Jury fee: \$10.00. Jury fee is not refundable. Entry fee: \$175.00. Entry fee is refunded to artists not accepted. Please submit fees in two separate checks payable to the Ozaukee Art Center. Booth fees are not refundable after acceptance. Supply email.
- SLIDES/PHOTOS:** Each slide or photo must include artist's name, media, and type of work printed clearly on each side. Work should be current (done within the last two years). It is important that the slides or photos include all types of work offered for sale. No glass mounts please. Slides or photos marked unclearly or of poor quality will be returned not judged. Slides or photos will not be returned without a self-addressed stamped envelope. Accepted artists' slides or photos will be returned at the Festival.
- DISPLAY:** Artist must display within his designated 10'x10' space and must provide all props, backdrops, displays and rain canopies. A consistent display must be maintained throughout the Festival. Artists are expected to exhibit in person on both days. Ribbons will not be given to artists not exhibiting on Sunday. Festivals of Cedarburg, Inc., City of Cedarburg, Ozaukee Art Center and the sponsors of the Festival, it's officers, agents, or employees cannot be held responsible for accidental loss or damage of any kind, or damage to any property or works of art on display or belonging to artists, and hold harmless officers or agent. Please read, understand and agree to observe all rules included herewith upon signing entry card.
- SALES:** All proceeds go to the artist. Each artist is responsible for collecting Wisconsin State sales tax of 0.056% on all sales made during the Festival.
