- Carving tools and paddles supplied by Festivals. Entrants must supply their own decorations and tools needed to decorate (i.e., spray paint, sails, etc.).
- All entrants must sign this waiver before competing.
- Anyone participating must wear a life jacket at all times while in the water, supplied by Festivals.
- No motors or batteries are to be used to power the boats.
- Rescue personnel will be on site for assistance should they be needed.
- Skipper must be 18 years old or over. Photo ID may be requested as proof.
- Trophies will be awarded at the Boy Scout House immediately following the race. Prize money will be mailed to local charity on winner's behalf.
